 43(37). Dorsum of postpetiole coarsely, and predominantly transversely, reticulo-rugose (Fig. 57, left); node of petiole truncate in profile *texanus* Wheeler
 — Dorsum of postpetiole punctate or granulose (Fig. 57, right), rarely reticulo-rugose, rugae often present on sides of node, node of petiole in profile occasionally with sharp apex (Fig. 54) 44
 44(43). Postpetiole very large, at least 1.6 X as wide as petiole and half
