

Five Species of Formicidae Newly Recorded in China

Abstract Five species of the ant family Formicidae newly recorded in China were discovered in the Xishuangbanna Nature Reserve of Southern Yunnan and Tongbiguan Nature Reserve of Western Yunnan. These species are: *Pachycondyla bispinosa* Smith, *Crematogaster anthracina* Smith, *Tetramorium indosinense* Wheeler, *Myrmoteras binghamii* Forel, and *Polyrhachis bihamata* (Drury). *Myrmoteras* Forel is a new record genus in China. Measurements and illustrations are supplemented for the worker caste of each species.
