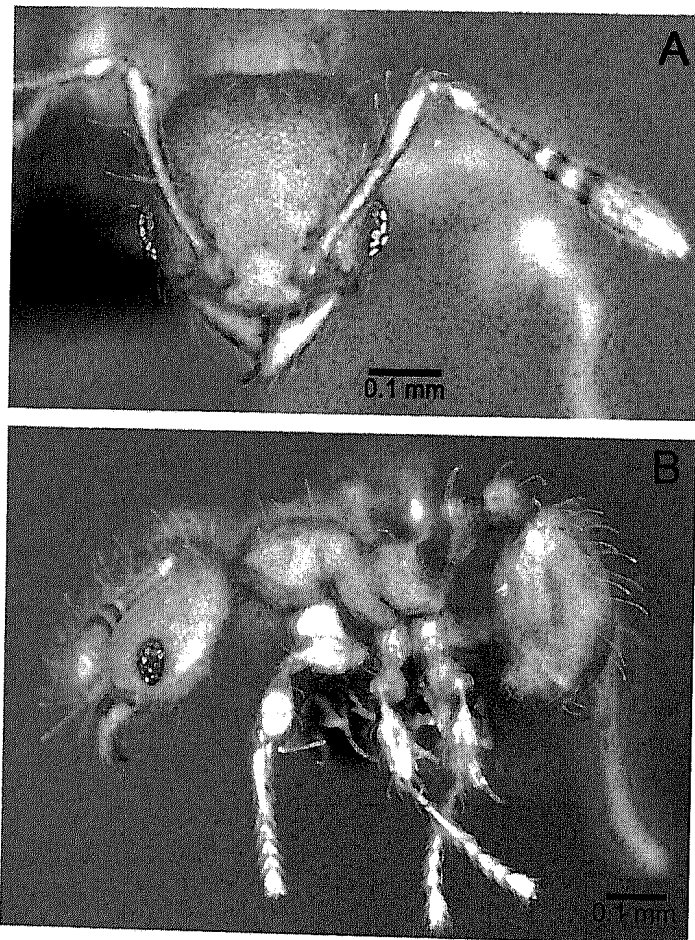


Figure 3. Paratype minor of *Pheidole schultzi*. A) head in full frontal view; B) in lateral view.
