Black; legs castaneous red; pubescence fine, dense, silky, silvery and hiding the sculpture; thorax convex, pronotal spines short, acute, pointing forwards; metanotal spines straight, pointing backwards, a somewhat distinct ridge between them across the metanotum; node of pedicel biconvex, with two short teeth on its middle margin, laterally with two long wide spreading spines curved to the shape of the abdomen.
