Typhlatta ceylonica Mayr, 1866: 505 (combination in *Aenictus* by DallaTorre, 1893: 7). Type locality: Sri Lanka (Ceylon).

Aenictus ceylonicus var. latro Forel, 1901: 477. Type locality: India, Poona.

Aenictus ceylonicus: Wilson 1964: 452 (part); Bolton 1995: 59 (part); Shattuck 2008: 16 (part).

Type material examined. *Typhlatta ceylonica*: Three syntype workers from Sri Lanka (NHMW, examined). One worker among them is selected as the lectotype
