transverse rugae, declivous face smooth. Dorsal portions of metasternal flanges not fused together as in worker. Ventral lobe of petiolar peduncle with a few erect hairs, dorsal surface of postpetiolar node shagreened with transverse striae or with transverse and longitudinal rugae. Forewing with one cubital cell (Fig. 6), body color uniformly light orange.

The gyne of *P. texanus* will not key to another species in the revision of the genus by Cole (1968).
