

♂. Brown, head and scale darker; apex of mandibles, funiculus, and legs dirty yellow; very finely punctured, covered with fine, short, silky pubescence, which is sparser than in the ♀.

*Frontal furrow* distinct, reaching from base of frontal area to median ocellus; *eyes* large, without outstanding hairs; *mandibles* furnished with four small teeth and one long one at apex; *scape* with very short decumbent hairs; *wings* as in the ♀. *Scale* high, erect, deeply emarginate at apex forming two sharp points, or teeth, which are more pointed than in the ♀, fringed with short fine bristles. *Tibiae* without outstanding hairs. *Gaster* furnished with bristles above and beneath.

Long. 4 mm.
