Subfamily CERAPACHYINÆ.

Tribe CERAPACHYINI.

Cerapachys antennatus Smith ?

♂. Shining black, mandibles, apex of gaster, post-petiole beneath at base, trochanters, knees, tarsi, and antennæ more or less, reddish. Clothed with longer and shorter outstanding yellow hairs.
