Tribe ECITINI.

Ænictus (Ænictus) bidentatus, sp. n.

♂.—Reddish yellow, thorax darker, pedicel, gaster, antennæ and legs lighter, more yellow, smooth and shining, except epinotum, which is slightly rugosely
