THE ANT *CATAGLYPHIS BIRMANA* A SYNONYM —
The specimen described as *Cataglyphis birmana* by Collingwood in 1962 (Ent. Tidskr., 83: 227, figs. 8, 9; type locality Malvedaung, Tenasserim, Burma, 300 m) is a worker minor of *Camponotus singularis* (= *Formica singularis* F. Smith, 1868, Cat. Hym. Brit. Mus., 6: 27; type locality "Java.") *New synonymy*. The type of *C. birmana* was loaned by Dr. Eric Kjellander through the courtesy of Mr. C. A. Collingwood, and has been returned to the Naturhistoriska Riksmuseet, Stockholm. — W. L. Brown, Jr., Department of Entomology, Cornell University.
