recorded by either Wheeler nor Mayr and this would have helped clariplacement of these specimens within this tribe.

MATERIAL EXAMINED.

None. Neither type specimen nor Wheeler's specimen could l located in spite of numerous queries of most European museums (thos listed among museums earlier).
